Introduction:

- A. Commanded to take the good news of Jesus to the whole world
- B. Those that respond through obedience will be delivered from sin and darkness
- C. What does it look like to evangelize to lost individuals? Let's look at Jesus as our example.

I. Jesus Countered the Model (John 4:4-9, 27)

- A. History of avoidance and animosity between the Jews and Samaritans
- B. Jesus didn't avoid Samaritan territory - John 4:4
- C. Samaritan woman's reaction - John 4:9
- D. Jesus was willing to cross many cultural boundaries in order to save a lost should

II. Jesus Captured the Moment (John 4:6-26)

- A. Jesus turned an ordinary situation/conversation into something greater.
- B. Jesus began a friendship and turned the friendship into a theological discussion
 - a. Ethics - John 4:16-18
 - b. Worship - John 4:19-24
 - c. Messiah - John 4:25-26

C. He used the setting of the "well" (John 4:11-12) to discuss a "fountain" (John 4:14)

III. Jesus Centered on the Messiah {Himself} (John 4:10, 13-14, 25-26)

- A. Samaritans focused on the Messiah as a prophet (John 4:19)
- B. Jesus informs her of living water and refers to Himself
 - a. Water will become a spring of water in a person
 - b. Water that satisfies
 - c. Psalms 36:9; Isaiah 12:3, 44:3; Jeremiah 2:13, 17:13; Zechariah 14:8; Revelation 21:6, 22:1
 - d. Jesus fully reveals His Messiahship to her - John 4:24-25

Application:

- A. Are we willing to cross boundaries to reach the lost?
- B. Are we looking for people in our daily activities who need to hear about Jesus?
- C. Are we willing to take "ordinary" moments and use them to share Jesus?
- D. Are we spreading the news about the only One who can satisfy our longing hearts?
