"His Life" — Jesus as Prophet Acts 7:51-60

Introduction:

- A. See their hands as they each pick up stones, motivated by the violent anger deep within their hearts.
- B. In those moments they gnawed their teeth. They laid their clothes at Saul's feet as they prepared to put all their might into carrying out this execution.

Discussion:

- A. The Identity of "The Prophet"
 - a. The Jews held Moses in high regard as a prophet.
 - 1. The Jews believed Moses prophesies.
 - 2. The problem was that so many of the Jews did not believe Jesus of Nazareth was a Prophet.
 - 3. And yet, Stephen's argument and plea was in showing how the Jews' rejection of Jesus was consistent with how their fathers had rejected other prophets of God.
 - b. The identity of the Prophet was a point of discussion.
- B. The Impression Jesus Made with His Teaching
 - a. Why was it so difficult for so many to believe Him?
 - 1. For those who at least recognized that Jesus was a teacher from God, they would often be left amazed at His teaching because it was different from what they would hear from the scribes.
 - 2. Hear this Man! So many had been so blinded to the truth. Hear Him!
