A. As the final week of Jesus' ministry began, Jesus made plans to enter Jerusalem.

B. John 12:12-19

#### Discussion:

A. He Rode in as King

- a. Donkey seemed to be the traditional ride of a king in the O.T.
- b. Examples Judges 10:4; Judges 12:14; 2 Samuel 16:1-2
- B. He Rode in as the Prophesied King
  - a. The thought of the Messiah on mind of many during the Passover.
  - b. Genesis 49:10-11; Matthew 21:5
  - c. Most accurate prophecy about Jesus as the Messiah Zechariah 9:9
- C. He Rode in as a Humble King
  - a. Zechariah 9:9 makes mention of the humility of a king on a donkey Zech 9:9-10
  - b. No one will ever be forced to serve Jesus
- D. He Rode in as an Eternal King
  - a. 1 Timothy 6:13-16 Paul leaves little doubt about Jesus' Kingship
  - b. Revelation 15:2-4

#### Conclusion:

- B. It starts with the people proclaiming Him as King of the Jews and it ends with the leaders mockingly putting it on His cross.
